Virginia Beach Department of Public Health Covid 19 Booster Shots, Moderna boosters are available for ages 6+ and Pfizer boosters are available for ages 12+. You are eligible for the bivalent booster if you have completed the primary series and it has been at least 2 months since your last booster dose. If you have already received a bivalent booster dose, you are up to date on COVID vaccinations. Second bivalent boosters are not authorized at this time. Walk-ins are also welcome. To schedule an appointment, visit http://www.vase.vdh.virginia.gov. Type "23457" into the zip code box. You can then select Moderna or Pfizer and schedule an appointment. If you need additional assistance scheduling an appointment, please call (877) VAX-IN-VA. The call center can assist with scheduling, answering questions about vaccination and other COVID-19 topics, and more.

IRA Charitable Contributions

Did you know that if you are subject to required minimum distributions from your traditional IRA, you can avoid paying taxes on that distribution? You can authorize a direct contribution from your IRA to a recognized 501(c)(3) charity. That distribution needs to be made by year end. That qualified charitable distribution can be deducted from your taxable income. Senior Fraud Resources

Financial scams and abuses that target older people are happening more and more. Reporting suspected fraud is the first step. Reporting can help authorities try to stop those who commit fraud and also help prevent others from becoming victims. According to FBI statistics, in 2021 there were 92,000 fraud victims over the age of 60, causing losses of over \$1.7 billion!! This was an increase of 74% over the amount lost in 2020. And these numbers just represent reported cases of fraud. Too many seniors are embarrassed about being scammed and don't tell even their closest relatives, let alone file a report. Nursing Home and Assisted Living Lists, Ratings and Inspections

Are you facing the placement of a loved one into an assisted living facility or nursing home locally? If so, there are resources available for you to narrow down your search. The State of Virginia Department of Social Services provides both a master list of area licensed assistive living facilities, but they also list inspection results for each place. Check out: <u>https://virginia.gov/facility/search/alf.cgi</u> or just search keywords Virginia DSS and look for assisted living information.

If you are looking for licensed nursing homes for intermediate, long-term care, Medicare provides helpful ratings of local facilities. Go to: <u>www.medicare.gov/care-compare</u>. They use a 5-star rating system, so you can see how each site measures up. They compare the quality of care and staffing ratios. Keep in mind that there is a critical shortage of certified nursing aides in facilities and in home care agencies as well, so almost all nursing homes and agencies are struggling with too few aides.

New EVMS Institute Opens

The EVMS Laurence J. Goldrich Institute for Integrated Neuro Health will provide comprehensive, multidisciplinary care for patients diagnosed with Parkinson's and other neurodegenerative diseases. It will also provide support systems for patients and their families, improve access to new drug therapies and clinical trials, and accelerate research.
